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### 1. Why am I using Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower?

Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower is not approved for treatment of any specific conditions or symptoms. Your doctor can indicate the desired symptom or condition for which this medication has been prescribed to you.

The active ingredient of Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower and is  $\Delta^9$ -Tetrahydrocannabinol

Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower may be used to aid in the treatment of a range of conditions, including, but not limited to:

- Provide pain relief
- Provide relief from nausea
- Improve sleep
- Improve anxiety
- Increase appetite
- Reduce spasticity
- Reduce occurrence of seizures

The therapeutic benefits of medicinal cannabis may vary depending on a patient's biology and the product selected. This list is not exhaustive. Your doctor will advise you on if medicinal cannabis may be used in your circumstances.

### 2. What should I know before I use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower?

#### Warnings

Do not use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower if:

- You have a history of hypersensitivity or allergy to  $\Delta^9$ -tetrahydrocannabinol, cannabidiol, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- You have severe and unstable heart disease (angina, peripheral vascular disease, cerebrovascular disease and arrhythmias) or risk factors for heart disease
- You are pregnant/breastfeeding
- you have a serious mental health disorder, such as psychosis. This does not include depression, anxiety, or post-traumatic stress disorder that result from your condition.

Discuss the following with your doctor:

- Any allergies to medicines, food, dyes or preservatives that you may have.
- Any medicines that you are taking, especially other sedatives such as opioids and benzodiazepines.
- Any medicines, supplements, vitamins or preparations that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.
- Medicinal cannabis can interact with other medicines, including strong painkillers, medicines used to treat anxiety, depression, epilepsy, aids for sleep, or muscle relaxants. This list is not exhaustive. Speak to your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure if you are taking any of these medications.
- If you are under 25, due to the potentially adverse effects on the developing brain
- If you have severe liver or renal disease
- If you have a history of drug dependence, including nicotine and heavy use of alcohol
- Are elderly or very young as these age groups of patients are likely to be more sensitive to the pharmacological effects of medicinal cannabis

Go to Accident and Emergency at the nearest hospital or call 000 if you notice any of the following:

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- Signs of an allergic reaction such as skin rash, itching or hives; swelling of the face, lips or tongue which may cause difficulty in swallowing or breathing, wheezing or shortness of breath

During treatment, you may be at risk of developing certain side effects. It is important you understand these risks and how to monitor for them. See additional information under [Section 6. Are there any side effects?](#)

## Pregnancy and breastfeeding

Check with your doctor if you are pregnant or intend to become pregnant.

Talk to your doctor if you are breastfeeding or intend to breastfeed.


## 3. What if I am taking other medicines?

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any medicines, vitamins or supplements that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

There is limited evidence about how medicinal cannabis reacts with other medications. Most interactions are associated with drugs that slow down the nervous system such as sedatives, benzodiazepines, and hypnotics.

Other drug interactions may include:

- Anti-depressants (*Fluoxetine, Fluvoxamine*)
- Anti-coagulants (*Warfarin, Apixaban, Rivaroxaban*)
- Antiretroviral drugs used in the treatment of HIV/AIDS
- Stomach acid inhibitors (*Omeprazole*)
- Certain antibiotic and antifungal medications
- Some heart medications (*Amiodarone, Diltiazem, Verapamil*)
- Some anti-epileptic medications (*Carbamazepine, Phenytoin, Clobazam*)
- St John's Wort.

Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure about what medicines, vitamins or supplements you are taking and if these interact with Sunco Green  Dried Flower

## 4. How do I use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower?

How much and when to take / use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower

- Always follow the directions of your doctor regarding how much and how often you should use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower.
- Use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower until your doctor tells you to stop.

## How much to take / use?

**Use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower exactly as prescribed by your doctor.**

- To find the ideal dosage, it is highly recommended to begin at the lowest possible dose and increase slowly as ideal dosage may differ per individual.
- This is to allow a person to achieve the best relief, whilst minimizing side effects of the treatment.

The following is a guide for finding the ideal dosage for your condition:

1. Inhale once and wait 15 minutes.
  2. If the desired therapeutic effect does not occur, inhale twice and wait 15 minutes.
  3. Continue this process increasing the number of inhalations every 15 minutes until the desired therapeutic effect occurs.
- Once the ideal dosage of Lumir SX6/31 is found for your condition, continue to take that dose as per your doctor's advice.

**Take Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower as directed by your doctor**

## If you forget to use Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower

**Do not take a double dose to make up for a missed dose.**

## If you use too much Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower

If you think that you have used too much Lumir SX6/31, you may need urgent medical attention.

You may experience:

- Hallucinations (auditory, smell, or visual).
- Noticeable change in heart rate.
- Feeling of confusion, drowsiness, of dizziness.

**You should immediately:**

- phone the Poisons Information Centre (**by calling 13 11 26**), or
- contact your doctor, or
- go to the Emergency Department at your nearest hospital.

**You should do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning.**

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## 5. What should I know while using Sunco Green Pollens Dried Flower

### Things you should do

Tell your doctor that you are taking Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower:

- Before starting any new medicine
- If you become pregnant
- If you plan to have surgery, including dental surgery
- If you are about to have any blood tests

If your condition is worsening while using Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower you should notify your doctor.

### Things you should not do

- Do not stop taking your medicine suddenly.
- This medicine is only available with a doctor's prescription. Possession of this medication without a prescription is illegal and may lead to prosecution, fines, or both.
- Do not allow others to use this medicine

### Driving or using machines

You should not drive or operate machinery while being treated with Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower. Measurable concentrations of THC can be detected many days after the last dose. It may take up to 5 days for 80-90% of the THC to be excreted. Drug-driving is a criminal offence. You should discuss the implications for safe and legal driving with your doctor.

### Drinking alcohol

Tell your doctor if you drink alcohol.

Do not consume Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower and alcohol at the same time as their effects may magnify each other's.

### Looking after your medicine

- Store below 25 degrees Celsius in a cool dry place away from moisture, heat or sunlight
- Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower does not need to be refrigerated

Do not store your medicine:

- In the bathroom or near a sink, or
- In the car or on a windowsill
- KEEP IT OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

## Getting rid of any unwanted medicine

- If you no longer need to use this medicine or it is out of date, take it to any pharmacy for safe disposal.
- Do not use this medicine after the expiry date.

## 6. Are there any side effects?

All medicines, including medicinal cannabis, can have side effects. The extent of these may vary with the type of medicinal cannabis product and between individuals.

See the information in the table below and ask your doctor or pharmacist if you have any further questions about side effects.

Less serious side effects	What to do

Serious side effects	What to do
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Low blood pressure</li><li>• Paranoia</li><li>• Depression</li><li>• Failure of muscle coordination</li><li>• Increased heart rate</li><li>• Diarrhoea</li><li>• Severe nausea or vomiting</li></ul>	<b>Call your doctor immediately or go straight to the Emergency Dept at your nearest hospital if you notice any of these serious side effects.</b>

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you notice anything else that may be making you feel unwell.

Other side effects not listed here may occur.

### Reporting side effects

By reporting side effects, you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

Always make sure you speak to your doctor or pharmacist before you decide to stop taking any of your medicines.

What Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower contains

Active ingredient (main ingredient)	$\Delta 9$ -tetrahydrocannabinol
Other ingredients (inactive ingredients)	Traces of other cannabinoids Traces of terpenes

Do not take this medicine if you are allergic to any of these ingredients.

What Sunco Green Novum Dried Flower looks like

Sunco Green Novum Dried Cannabis Flower is 10 g of dried flower material and is supplied in a plastic cannister with child resistant cap and a tamper evident plastic ring tab. Do not use the medicine if the tamper evident plastic ring tab has been removed or damaged.
